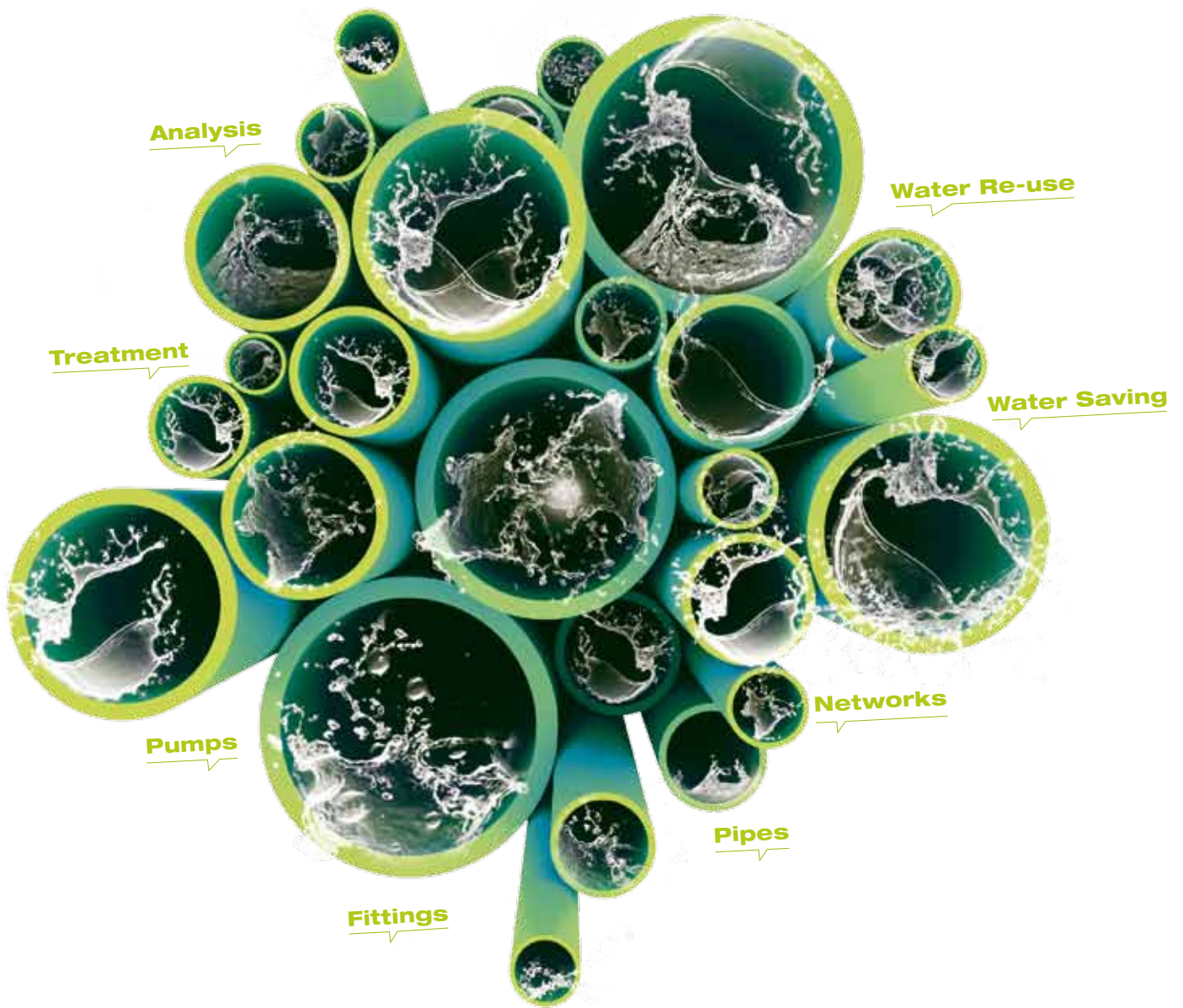

GROWTH SUSTAINED BY HYDROCARBONS AND PUBLIC SPENDING

- Forecasts for economic growth > 4% in 2011*
- Average rate close to 5% up to 2015*

- Very low external debt (2010: 25.7% of GDP)*
- Enormous foreign exchange reserves: one of the world's top 15 countries for the size of its reserves, which stood at nearly US\$174 billion at the end of June 2011

Sector news (list not complete)**:

MOBILIZATION OF SURFACE WATER

- Start of **2** new **dams** (and work on 13 other projects underway)
- **Transfer** to the Sétif plateaux
- Major **transfer** of water from the transient Chott El Gharbi lake to the neighbouring wilayas over a distance of **649 km**
- Studies for the project to **transfer** of water from northern albien to Djelfa, Boussaâda, M'sila and Tiaret
- **Work to interconnect** the 5 dams forming the Beni Haroun system

DESALINATION

- Hand over of 5 out of a **programme of 13 desalination plants** and their downstream equipment (target: production of 2.26 million m³/day)

DECENTRALIZED MANAGEMENT

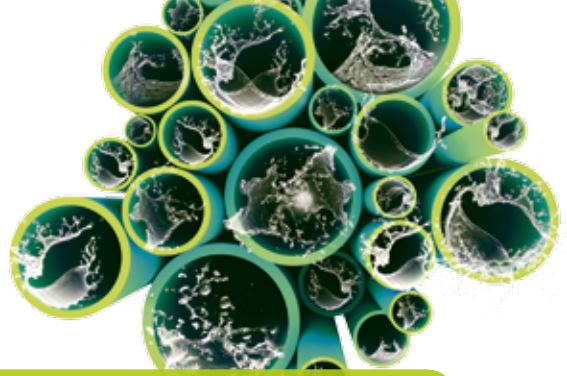
- Throughout the country: numerous **drinking water supply, sewerage, flood protection** projects, **treatment plants** construction projects, **bore holes, hill reservoirs**, agricultural **irrigation** projects...

INTEGRATED WATER MANAGEMENT:

- Creation of **regional strategic reserves** (combination of surface, underground and non-conventional resources)
- **Delegated management** of public water and sewerage services in the country's major conurbations.
- **National deployment** of the ADE and ONA units and agencies
- Development of **irrigated** agriculture
- Water **saving**
